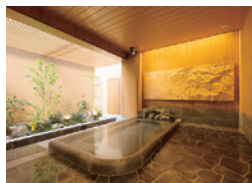

Dōgo Time Exploration "Dōgo Toki (time) meguri"

Dōgo Onsen Honkan sounds the Toki Daiko ("time drum") to announce the time three times each day. Dōgo Time Exploration offers recommendations for walks around town based on the theme of "time," which may indicate the different timeframes during which various types of atmospheres can be experienced, the changing of the seasons, or cultural customs passed down over times past.

Coin lockers are located next to the bus stop and the Tourist Information Center. If all lockers are full, consult the Tourist Information Center (8:30 am-5 pm).

- 1 Botchan Karakuri Clock & Footbath** 坊っちゃんカラクリ時計・足湯

The hot spring district at dusk becomes lively with many travelers. Soak your feet in the free-flowing hot spring footbath, or watch the dancing dolls in the marionette clock (every hour between 8 am and 10 pm; every 30 minutes on Saturdays, Sundays, holidays, and busy periods).

- 2 Dōgo Shopping Arcade** 道後商店街

About 65 souvenir shops and restaurants are squeezed into a 250m-long L-shape path. Get yourself some Ehime specialty products.

- 3 Dōgo Onsen Honkan** 道後温泉本館

During construction, the entrance is on the east side that houses the Yūshinden/Tama-no-Yu wing. The newly installed signboard makes it a nice spot for photos.

Yu-no-daijizō, a giant white jizō statue, sits peacefully. Popular here are colorful and auspicious omusubi dama ("knot balls").

- 5 Himitsu ja Nai Base** ひみつじナイ基地

Climb to the top of Shōnin-zaka Slope and stop by to relax in this local exchange base where workshops and exhibitions are held. Open 11:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. and closed on Tuesdays and Wednesdays (with occasional temporary closures).

- 6 Hōgon-ji Temple** 宝蔵寺

From Hōgon-ji Temple at the top of the Shōnin-zaka Slope, you can view beautiful sunsets and the Matsuyama Castle. Crop the view using the temple gate as a frame.

- 7 Isaniwa-jinja Shrine** 伊佐爾波神社

From atop the 135 stone steps, you can look down a straight road extending westward and over the town. In the distance are Matsuyama Castle and an expansive, stunning view.

End the tour of the town by taking a bath in a newly-opened hot spring. With a package course that includes the use of the bath and resting room, you can enjoy an after-bath refreshment of tea and sweets while wearing a yukata.
